PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)

The course aims to developing scientific knowledge, academic skills and practical skills in the assessment of the economic functions of the state system and the intervention of the state in economy according to modern development trends in economic policy as a scientific discipline, to enable students to understand the methods, procedures and processes of research of macroeconomic categories, and to acquire specific skills needed for their future career. On completion of the course program, students are expected to: 1) acquire knowledge about economic policy and its impact on economic, social and political spheres of social life; 2) understand the economic functions of the state and its authorities; 3) acquire knowledge about the relationship between economic policies and the legal system; 4) develop a systematic approach to macroeconomic problems and offer critical and analytical responses on issue concerning the implementation of specific economic policy; 5) acquire the key terms, concepts and macroeconomic categories.

Concept and content of Economic Policy (the objects, goals, resources, instruments, measures of economic policy). Economic policy program. Economic policy and economic system. Basic stages in the development of economic policy. Concept and types of markets. Market and prices. Monopoly and anti-monetary policy. Monetary and credit policy. Financial market. Public expenditures. Individual consumption policy. Fiscal system and fiscal policy. Investment policy. The policy of international economic relations. International economic institutions and agreements. The basic elements of developmental economic policy and economic reform in Serbia. Economic development. Fiscal policy, Environmental policy. Policy of Technological Development. Policy of Regional Development. Foreign trade policy. Foreign investments. Human and Sustainable Development.
